- Design instrument rated metering for applicable accounts, including polyphase meters. Coordinate with line crews on the installation and provide site visits for verification.
- Manage and maintain AMI (Automated Meter Infrastructure) Systems
- Provide technical support to identify and resolve unusual system occurrences and/or stray voltages problems.
- Manage and maintain SCADA system, including design, programming, training and support, and administrative functions.
- Assist with OMS system management.
- Conduct Substation Inspections.
- Education and consulting with members and installers on solar inquiries and installations. Perform and assist on solar interconnections.
- Assist and train, as necessary, Remote Dispatchers. Perform site visits for installation, maintenance, and repair of REA equipment.
- Provide support for safety programs and procedures.
- Provide internal engineering and/or technical support as required while complying with REA Energy Cooperative Safe Work Practice Manual.
